4. Formulate a WISH (What I See Happening) list for 6 months in the future

5/10/00	Intro to material (texts available for purchase). Names & needs assessment: what do you want from class? Make WISH & put in well (revisit 5/31). Group agreements. Talk topics: <i>Substance</i> and <i>Faith/Trust</i> . Trust circle exercise. Small group discussion on “What is your passion? (Where is your faith?)” Round table report-out from discussion groups. Draw name of Prosperity Prayer Partner. Pray out.	Begin daily appointment with Spirit and keep activity log.** Read ch. 1 thru 4 in <i>Spiritual Economics</i> Write your personal definition of divine “substance”
5/17/00	Group report-in of “substance” definitions. Talk topics: <i>Money</i> and <i>Tithing/Giving</i> . Gourmet exercise. Small group discussion of tithing to spiritual nourishment. Report out. Daily appointment discussion. WISHING (--I Now Get) Well pray over and out.	Read ch. 9 -12 in <i>Spiritual Economics</i> Write personal experience**

5/24/00	Group report-in. Talk topics: <i>Debts</i> and <i>Overcoming Lack</i> . Anxiety wall exercise. Small group discussion on "What's my dot?" Round table sharing of personal manifestations and report-out on "dot" discussion. WISHING Well pray over and out.	Read ch. 5 thru 8 in <i>Spiritual Economics</i> Create WISH list for six months ahead -bring list & activity log to class 5/31
5/31/00	Group report-in of personal experience in staying prayed up. Talk topics: <i>Security</i> and <i>Gratitude</i> . "Where is God?" exercise. Small group discussion "Is the Universe a safe place?" Retrieve WISHes, round table discussion re manifestation/changes. Address envelopes and seal in 6-month WISH lists; put envelopes in safe for mailing November 30. Evaluation & feedback. Pray out.	

** Explanations:

Daily Appointment With Spirit

Commit to prayer every day. This can be as simple as stating your WISH once a day. You could also spend 5 minutes in silence and gratitude; take an "Empowered Shower" (see bookstore table for cards); review the day and release to God before bed; actually set aside a meditation/prayer time daily. Whatever you choose, DO IT EVERY DAY and keep a log of your prayer activity. (If you wish, this could also be a journal of insights received from committed prayer activity in your life; however, you will only be asked to share "how" you connected with Spirit daily when you bring your log to class.)

Personal Experience

Reflect on when you expected something to happen and it did (most likely, not as you pictured it!). This could be anything from something feared that appeared to a treasure map manifestation. We have all held a thought in mind and seen it produce after its kind. Write on an AHA experience, one which you will be comfortable sharing in class.
