The 2008 **Field Licensing Intensive Week**, Mar 6-14, will host 55 returning candidates and mentors, and 13 applicants and new mentors for a total of 80 participants. We plan to license 25 and ordain 8 as Unity ministers. New applicants will also be interviewed for admission into the program.
