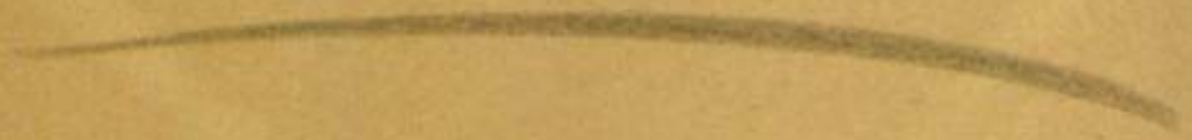
Search me, O God, and
