of our duties by the place
we give them in ~~our~~
the events of our everyday
life. The ^{simplest and most universal} worship of God

is in prayer. Does the average
 Christian pray to God as an
 everywhere present Spirit, or
 does he pray to him as a
 being located in a place
 in the skies called heaven?

Ask the Episcopalian minister
 in the big stone church on the
 next corner, or the Methodist

ministers around the corner,
 about this and you will
 find that they ~~don't~~ make
 their prayers to a localized
 god, ~~having~~ a god who
~~has his residence to a city~~
 has a throne in a city
 in a locality called heaven.

the average Christian.

Then there are altars everywhere
to the "Unknown God." ~~But~~ There
is no such God as these people
worship, and, as they do not
know the everywhere Principle
