III Nathaniel Fillmore 8th child, 3rd son of John II + Darcas Day.
 was born in Norwich, Conn. as a young man he went on
 foot thru the wilderness of Vermont, with his brother Luther.
 He helped found Bennington Vt. Town office 1768, other offices frequently.
 He was Captain in the Battle of Bennington 16 Aug. 1777 after which
 he became Colonel. He carried the first American flag, made
 to carry into Battle. It was carried in a celebration in Wash. D.C.
 and is now in the Shrine of Vermont Museum, the Congl
 Church built by Seneca Fillmore's compact, of John II in 1806

Nathaniel was also in the French and Indian war, where he
 was wounded, left in the woods, and subsisted for nearly a week
 on a few kernels of corn, also roasted his shoes and blanket for warmth.
 He was a long line of descendants in Vermont. He was the father
 of Nathaniel Jr. - father of President Millard Fillmore.
 He had six children, Nathaniel, Simon, Phillipa, Calvin, Elijah, Darius.

IV Simon Fillmore, son of Nathaniel was born in Bennington
 and married Susanna Glegen there. In 1790 with his brother
 Calvin, went through the wilderness on foot to New York.

They helped found Clarence Erie Co. N.Y. in 1811
 He taught school, was town clerk, Supervisor and Justice of Peace
 the first master 1822. He did not become as wealthy as noted as with Calvin

"All the Fillmore men were of powerful frame, sensible tho'
 not highly educated men. Simon was generally recognized
 as a man of unblemished integrity and sound judgment."

He was the father of Glegen Fillmore, the first ordained M.E.
 minister in N.Y. State, who founded the first M.E. Church
 in Buffalo N.Y. which was built in 40 days

"The earliest home of the Phillimore Family from the XVI century downwards, was born in Gloucestershire England" W. P. W. Phillimore
Queen's College, Oxford England New Eng. Reg.

The name Fillmore, spelled Phillimore originally in England, also Filmer Robert Filmer lived in Herst or Herts Parish at Attendon England, in the time of Edward II. A descendant of the same name was prothonotary of court of common pleas in the reign of Queen Elizabeth. In 1570 he was granted a coat of arms "Sable 3 bars, 3 cinque foils in chief or".

In 1585 Sir Edward Fillmore of Little Charlton bought an estate in East Dutton, Co Kent England. He married Elizabeth daughter of Richard Argall, whose father Thomas Argall was heir of Dutton, Co Kent, England. William Fynmore of Reading, Eng. church warden of Reading 1565-6 Mayor of town 1577-1586 prob buried Reading church yard 1593 *Appleton's Encop. New Eng. Reg. 1700*

I John Phillimore, who arrived in New England before 1700 was a mariner, on his own ship. He was the ancestor of all the American Fillmores. He bought an estate in Ipswich, Mass, later Beverly Mass. 24 Nov. 1704. While on a homeward bound voyage from the East Indies, 1708 his ship was captured by a French frigate in Queen Anne's war. He was carried to Martinique and imprisoned there. He was ultimately redeemed but according to a narration of his son John II. He was poisoned by the French, on his homeward voyage all the other prisoners died on way home.

II John Fillmore II was under nine years of age when his father died. His ambition was to go to sea. His mother apprenticed him to a relative Capt. Mark Mastell at age of 17 and he sailed on a fishing sloop which was captured by the notorious pirate Capt. Phillips. He demanded John Fillmore, who consented to go on the pirate ship, to save his comrades. He suffered many hardships and cruel treatment but refused to sign the ship's papers. He plotted with two young Americans and an Indian to capture the ship. When the crew were drunk, the young men tied them up and sailed the ship into Boston Harbor where they turned it over to authorities *New Eng. Reg. 1700*
